

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Jagobiao, Mandaue City

### I. Situation Overview

On 18 June 2023 at around 11:24 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Manga, Brgy. Jagobiao, Mandaue City. The fire was declared out at around 11:55 AM.
