I. Situation Overview

On 14 June 2023 at around 11:38 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Lake Danao, Ormoc City. The fire was declared out at around 1:15 AM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱906.64 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱3.66 million available at DSWD FO VIII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 208,450 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 121,408 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 87,042 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 58,191 FFPs available at DSWD FO VIII.
- ₱278.27 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VIII warehouses.

b. Other Activities

DATE	ACTIVITIES
17 June 2023	 DSWD FO VIII coordinated with the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) of the LGU of Ormoc City to monitor the provision of psychosocial first aid (PFA) to victims of the fire incident.
16 June 2023	 DSWD FO VIII provided financial assistance to the affected families through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS) amounting to a total of ₱620,000.00. DSWD FO VIII continuously coordinated with concerned offices for significant updates and any request for relief augmentation.
