



DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the African Swine Fever Outbreak in Region VI

as of 04 July 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

With confirmed cases and reports on the spread of the African Swine Fever (ASF) in Western Visayas (Region VI), the effects of ASF has placed the provinces of Aklan and Capiz as well as the municipality of Hamtic in Antique under State of Calamity (SoC) on 19 May 2023, 13 June 2023, and 22 June 20223 respectively.

ASF is a highly contagious viral disease of domestic and wild pigs, where mortality rate can reach 100%. It is not a danger to human health, but it has devastating effects on pig populations and the farming economy. There is currently no effective vaccine against ASF. The virus is highly resistant in the environment, meaning that it can survive on clothes, boots, wheels, and other materials. It can also survive in various pork products, such as ham, sausages or bacon.

A total of **6,308 families** or **31,667 persons** are affected in **128 barangays** in **Region VI** (see Table 1).
