



# DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Davao Region

## I. Situation Overview

On 05 June 2023, a flash flood incident occurred in the municipality of Asuncion, Davao del Norte while flooding was experienced in the municipality of Sto. A total of **2,561 families** or **7,665 persons** are affected in **nine (9) barangays** in the **Davao Region** (see Table 1).
