

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. North Daang Hari, Taguig City as of 07 June 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 31 May 2023 at around 2:20 PM, a fire incident occurred at Manggahan Rd., Brgy. North Daang Hari, Taguig City. The fire was declared out at around 5:55 PM.
