I. Situation Overview

On 31 May 2023 at around 2:20 PM, a fire incident occurred at Manggahan Rd., Brgy. North Daang Hari, Taguig City. The fire was declared out at around 5:55 PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱146.78 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 165,261 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 91,719 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 73,542 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 4,771 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱233.16 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
