

DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Davao Region as of 12 June 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 June 2023, a flash flood incident occurred in the Municipality of Asuncion, Davao del Norte while flooding was experienced in the Municipality of Sto. Tomas in the same province on 07 June 2023 due to the effects of the localized thunderstorms.

A total of **20 families** or **39 persons** sought temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Nabunturan, Davao de Oro** (see Table 2).
