I. Situation Overview

On 26 May 2023 at around 2:00 PM, an armed conflict transpired between two (2) armed groups in the Municipality of Datu Odin Sinsuat.

A total of **638 families** or **3,190 persons** were affected in **five (5) barangays** in **Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao** (see Table 1).
