



# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Macagahay, Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental

26 August 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 13 June 2023, an armed conflict between the Philippine Army and the New People's Army (NPA) transpired in Brgy. Macagahay, Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental which resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

A total of **119 families** or **334 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Macagahay, Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental** (see Table 1).

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of 119 families or 334 persons sought temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental (see Table 2).
