

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Talon Uno and Talon Singko, Las Piñas City

23 November 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On May 15, 2023, a fire incident occurred in Barangays Talon Uno and Talon Singko, Las Piñas City. The fire ignited at 3:12 in the afternoon and was officially declared fire out at 9:30 pm.

The incident led to the displacement of 420 families, equivalent to 1,650 individuals, who have already returned to their respective residences. Notably, there were no recorded casualties.

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **239 families** or **913 persons** sought temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Las Piñas City** (see Table 2).
