



DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Talon Uno and Talon Singko, Las Piñas City

23 November 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On May 15, 2023, a fire incident occurred in Barangays Talon Uno and Talon Singko, Las Piñas City. The fire ignited at 3:12 in the afternoon and was officially declared fire out at 9:30 pm.

The incident led to the displacement of 420 families, equivalent to 1,650 individuals, who have already returned to their respective residences. Notably, there were no recorded casualties.

A total of **239 families** or **913 persons** sought temporary shelter in **four (4)** evacuation centers in Las Piñas City (see Table 2).
