# I. Situation Overview

On 18 June 2023 at around 4AM, the passenger vessel MV Esperanza Star of KHO Shipping Lines caught fire within the seawater vicinity of Brgy. Doljo, Panglao, Bohol. *Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) VII*

The MV Esperanza Star carried a total of 40 families or 71 persons (see Annex A).
