

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Surigao del Sur as of 26 July 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 July 2023 at around 9 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Almara, Brgy. Bigaan, Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur between the troops of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and the alleged members of the New People's Army (NPA) which also affected the nearby Brgy. Santa Juana in Tagbina, Surigao del Sur.

A total of **337 families** or **1,275 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Surigao del Sur** (see Table 1).
