I. Situation Overview

On 07 July 2023 at around 3AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 7, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 4:40 AM.

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 137,493 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 108,965 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 28,528 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
