V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}43,746.56\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}33,246.56\$ from DSWD, \$\mathbb{P}7,500.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU), and \$\mathbb{P}3,000.00\$ from Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) (see Table 4).

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 136,591 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 82,063 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 54,528 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 49,722 FFPs available at DSWD FO X.
- ₱331.36 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO X warehouses.





b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

20 July 2023	 DSWD FO X through its Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) facilitated the distribution of FNIs such as FFPs, family kits, hygiene kits, kitchen kits, sleeping kits, and ready-to- eat foods (RTEFs) to the affected families.
07 July 2023	The LGU of Medina, Misamis Oriental through its Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) immediately provided FNIs to the affected families.
