I. Situation Overview

On 11 July 2023 at around 8:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Lower Puting Bato in Brgy. Calumpang, General Santos City. The fire was declared out at around 11:00 PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱102.65 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 155,214 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 112,586 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 42,628 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
