### I. Situation Overview

On 14 July 2023 at around 10:10 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 2A, Brgy. Casinglot, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 10:40 AM. *Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) X*

A total of **12 families** or **52 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Casinglot, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental** (see Table 1).

### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 149,533 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 95,025 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 54,528 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 49,738 FFPs available at DSWD FO X.
- ₱287.71 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO X warehouses.
