V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}366,641.50\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}175,961.50\$ from DSWD, \$\mathbb{P}80,680.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU), and \$\mathbb{P}110,000.00\$ from other Partners (see Table 6).

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

La Union 2nd District Representative Dante Garcia extended assistance to affected families and individuals amounting to a total of ₱110,000.00.
