## I. Situation Overview

On 05 July 2023 at around 3:45 AM, a fire incident occurred at Gumamela Extn., Brgy. Gen. T. De Leon, Valenzuela City. The fire was declared out at around 4:28 AM.

#### 1. Standby Funds

- 140,214 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 111,686 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 28,528 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
