

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Guban, Sirawai, Zamboanga del Norte as of 08 July 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 04 July 2023 at around 12:40AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Guban, Sirawai, Zamboanga del Norte. According to the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), the cause of fire was due to electrical ignition.
