I. Situation Overview

On 04 July 2023 at around 12:40AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Guban, Sirawai, Zamboanga del Norte. According to the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), the cause of fire was due to electrical ignition.

- 137,493 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 108,965 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 28,528 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 34,391 FFPs available at DSWD FO IX.
- ₱310.2 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO IX warehouses.
