On 08 July 2023 at around 8:20 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Asinan, Brgy. Kasanyangan, Zamboanga City. The fire was declared out at around 11:15 PM.

#### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 137,493 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 108,965 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 28,528 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 34,167 FFPs available at DSWD FO IX.
- ₱309.13 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO IX warehouses.
