

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Dionisio, Parañaque City

as of 11 July 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 08 July 2023 at around 3:15 PM, a fire incident occurred at Valencia Compound, Brgy. San Dionisio, Parañaque City. The fire was declared out at around 5:44 PM.
