as of 19 July 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 July 2023 at around 1:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Melon St., Golden Acres, Brgy. Talon Uno, Las Piñas City. The fire was declared out at around 3:45 AM. *Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) NCR*

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **27 families** or **75 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Talon Uno, Las Piñas City** (see Table 1).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱98.87 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱4.9 million available at DSWD FO NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 145,406 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 90,878 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 54,528 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 7,136 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱249.73 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

18 July 2023	 The Local Government Unit (LGU) of Las Piñas City through its City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) provided hot meals to the affected families.

c. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)

18 July 2023	 The LGU of Las Piñas City through its CSWDO activated CCCM and other response clusters. The same office conducted intake interviews, assessment, validation, and master listing of the affected families.





d. Other Activities

DATE	ACTIVITIES
18 July 2023	 The LGU of Las Piñas City through its CSWDO continuously coordinates with concerned agencies and offices for the needs of the affected families. DSWD FO NCR continuously coordinates with the LGU of Las Piñas City and other concerned offices for significant updates and augmentations requests. DSWD FO NCR ensured the availability of FNIs for possible augmentation to Las Piñas City.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO NCR for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
