

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Talon Uno, Las Piñas City as of 19 July 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 18 July 2023 at around 1:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Melon St., Golden Acres, Brgy. Talon Uno, Las Piñas City. The fire was declared out at around 3:45 AM.
