



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incident in President Roxas, North Cotabato

as of 05 July 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 July 2023, a flash flood incident occurred in low-lying barangays in the Municipality of President Roxas in the province of North Cotabato due to heavy rains brought by the Easterlies.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **566 families** or **2,830 persons** are affected in **10 barangays** in **President Roxas**, **North Cotabato** (see Table 1).

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 189,222 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 111,380 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 77,842 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 24,015 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱279.77 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
