

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incident in President Roxas, North Cotabato

as of 05 July 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 July 2023, a flash flood incident occurred in low-lying barangays in the Municipality of President Roxas in the province of North Cotabato due to heavy rains brought by the Easterlies.

A total of **566 families** or **2,830 persons** are affected in **10 barangays** in **President Roxas, North Cotabato** (see Table 1).
