- 189,222 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 111,380 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 77,842 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 35,122 FFPs available at DSWD FO IX.
- ₱302.52 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO IX warehouses.
