

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Landslide Incident in Brgy. Talomo Proper, Davao City

as of 21 July 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 04 July 2023 at 4AM, cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms brought by the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) / Easterlies may have caused possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains to Eastern Visayas, Caraga, and Davao Region.

On the same day, a landslide incident occurred in Brgy. Talomo Proper, Davao City, Davao del Sur.
