



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Carabalan, Himamaylan, Negros Occidental

as of 12 July 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 July 2023 at around 9AM, an armed conflict transpired between the troops of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and members of the New People's Army (NPA) in Brgy. Carabalan, Himamaylan City.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱102.65 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 155,214 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 112,586 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 42,628 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 63,076 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱276.71 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
