as of 28 July 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 24 July 2023 at around 9 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Almara, Brgy. Bigaan, Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur between the troops of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and the alleged members of the New People's Army (NPA) which also affected the nearby Brgy. Santa Juana in Tagbina, Surigao del Sur.

## a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **76 families** or **334 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Surigao del Sur** (see Table 2).
