

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 23-C, Davao City as of 06 July 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 04 July 2023 at around 11PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 23-C, Davao City. The fire was declared out at around 2:42 AM.
