I. Situation Overview

On 08 July 2023 at around 8:20 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Asinan, Brgy. Kasanyangan, Zamboanga City. The fire was declared out at around 11:15 PM.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 144,523 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 101,895 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 42,628 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 32,150 FFPs available at DSWD FO IX.
- ₱322.48 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO IX warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)
