

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flooding Incident in Brgy. Balangasan, Pagadian City, Zamboanga del Sur as of 07 July 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 03 July 2023, a flooding incident occurred in Brgy. Balangasan, Pagadian City, Zamboanga del Sur due to continuous heavy rains brought by the Intertropical Convergence Zone.
