



DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Armed Conflict in Surigao del Sur

as of 01 August 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 July 2023 at around 9 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Almara, Brgy. Bigaan, Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur between the troops of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and the alleged members of the New People's Army (NPA) which also affected the nearby Brgy. Santa Juana in Tagbina, Surigao del Sur.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **359 families** or **1,356 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Surigao del Sur** (see Table 1).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}2,058,877.81\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}2,055,772.81\$ from \$\mathbb{D}SWD\$ and \$\mathbb{P}3,105.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Table 5).
