I. Situation Overview

On 08 July 2023 at around 8:20 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Asinan, Brgy. Kasanyangan, Zamboanga City. The fire was declared out at around 11:15 PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱98.86 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱2.5 million available at DSWD FO IX.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 136,591 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 82,063 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 54,528 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 36,576 FFPs available at DSWD FO IX.
- ₱348.64 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO IX warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

DATE	ACTIVITIES
21 July 2023	DSWD FO IX through its Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) provided family kits to the affected families.
10 July 2023	DSWD FO IX through its DRMD facilitated the provision of FFPs, sleeping kits, and hygiene kits to the affected families.
09 July 2023	 DSWD FO IX provided FFPs, sleeping kits, and hygiene kits to the affected families. The LGU of Zamboanga City immediately provided hot meals to the affected families. The cost of assistance provided by the LGU is yet to be determined.

c. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)

10 July 2023	Some of the displaced families have been transferred to a private lot while others chose to stay with their relatives or friends. Profiling, assessment, and validation of affected families were conducted by the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) of the LGU of Zamboanga City.





d. Other Activities

21 July 2023	 DSWD FO IX through its DRMD closely coordinated with the CSWDO and City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CCDRRMO) of the LGU of Zamboanga City for significant updates and any request for relief augmentation.
20 July 2023	• DSWD FO IX through the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS) provided financial assistance to the affected families amounting to a total of ₱4,060,000.00.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with DSWD FO IX for significant disaster response updates and assistance provided.
