On 13 May 2023, at around 4:32 PM, a fire incident transpired in Brgy. Estefania, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. According to the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), the cause of fire is due to faulty electrical wire. It was declared fire out at around 5:13 PM.
