

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Nataban, San Carlos City, Negros Occidental

02 July 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 May 2023, at around 5AM, a residential fire incident transpired in Brgy. Nataban, San Carlos City, Negros Occidental. According to the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), the cause of fire was due to flames from an unattended cook stove. It was declared fire out at around 5:55 AM.
