



# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Tawas, Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro

02 July 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 08 May 2023 at around 10PM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Pastuhan, Brgy. Tawas, Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro between the troops of the 203<sup>rd</sup> Infantry Brigade, 2<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Division of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines – New People's Army (CPP-NPA) that resulted in the displacement of families and individuals.

A total of **239 families** or **885 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Tawas, Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro** (see Table 1).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **67 families** or **276 persons** sought temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Bongabong**, **Oriental Mindoro** (see Table 2).
