

## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Southwest Monsoon enhanced by STY Betty

25 August 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 04 June 2023 at 4PM, the Southwest Monsoon continuously affected the western sections of Central and Southern Luzon.

A total of **2,123 families** or **7,643 persons** sought temporary shelter in **115 evacuation centers** in **Regions VI and VII** (see Table 2).
