



DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Landslide Incident in Brgy. Talomo Proper, Davao City

11 January 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 July 2023, the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Service Administration (PAGASA) issued its weather forecast stating that the Southern part of Mindanao will have partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms due to Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ).

On the same day, a landslide incident occurred in Brgy. Talomo Proper, Davao City, Davao del Sur.
