#### I. Situation Overview

On 29 July 2023 at around 6:20 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Pagas, Brgy. Ayabang, Leon, Iloilo between the Philippine Army's 61<sup>st</sup> Battalion troops and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA).
