I. Situation Overview

On 27 July 2023 at around 10AM, a crossfire incident between the Philippine Army and an unknown armed group occurred at Sitio Midsaker, Brgy. Limulan, Kalamansig, Sultan Kudarat.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱403.93 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 106,124 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 15,496 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 90,628 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 51,185 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱265.52 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
