



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Leon, Iloilo

as of 17 August 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 August 2023 at around 12:45 PM, an armed conflict transpired between the troops of the 61st Infantry Battalion of the Philippine Army and the members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) at the boundary of Brgy. Ayubo and Brgy. Cananaman in Leon, Iloilo.

Prior to the incident, the Philippine Army confirmed the reports of planned extortion and intimidation by the members of CPP-NPA and the armed encounter further raised fear amongst the families / persons residing in the affected areas.
