I. Situation Overview

On 05 August 2023 at around 4:59 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 650, Port Area, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 8:14 PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱274.11 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱4.9 million available at DSWD FO NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 106,480 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 8,852 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 97,628 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 8,194 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱246.02 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
