2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 97,072 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 4,960 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 92,112 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 37,255 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱282.73 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
