I. Situation Overview

On 10 August 2023 at around 12:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Hilub-ang, Calatrava, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 1:45 PM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) VI

- 94,872 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 2,760 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 92,112 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 37,255 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱283.04 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
