I. Situation Overview

On 14 July 2023 at around 4:04 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Soong, Brgy. Mactan, Lapu-lapu City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 4:40 PM.

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are nine (9) families or 42 persons currently taking temporary shelter in tents set by the LGU near a Basketball Court in Brgy. Mactan, Lapu-lapu City, Cebu (see Table 2).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱663.67 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 82,898 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 270 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 82,628 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 51.554 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱277.35 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.





b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

30 July 2023	DSWD FO VII through its Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) in coordination with the City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) of the LGU of Lapu-Lapu City provided FFPs, hygiene kits, kitchen kits, and sleeping kits to the families affected by the fire incident.
15 July 2023	The CSWDO of the LGU of Lapu-Lapu City provided packed meals and FNIs to the affected families.
