1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 82,898 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 270 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 82,628 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 49,761 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
