1. Standby Funds

- ₱576.52 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱4.9 million available at DSWD FO NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 98,505 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 9,793 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 88,712 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 8,194 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱267 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
